Consultants can expect to make \$85K-110K per year; senior-level architects can even make north of \$150K a year.

Microsoft has changed the world time and time again. Now their business applications arm is growing at a fast pace. This has created a vast career market that is starving for people. Power Learn seeks to take those stuck in careers that they hate and help them transition to high-paying – six-figure jobs in the technology consulting space.
